

Notice of Photography and Video Recording at Nesmith Library

Nesmith Library values sharing the vibrant community moments that happen within our walls. To engage with our community, we occasionally photograph and record programs, events, and library moments for use in our social media, newsletters, and other locations. The following outlines our photography and recording policy and what you can expect as a library visitor or program attendee.

Photography and Recording by Library Staff

By attending a Nesmith Library program or event you enter an area where photography, audio, and video recording may occur.

Nesmith Library reserves the right to use photographs, video, or audio recordings taken at the library for publicity purposes in printed materials, on official library social media channels, the Nesmith Library website, and in any printed or digital news or newsletters. Attendees and/or participants consent to having their photograph taken and used for such purposes.

By entering the Nesmith Library or Nesmith Library events, you waive and release any claims you may have related to the use of recorded media of you at the event, including, without limitation, any right to inspect or approve the photo, video or audio recording of you, any claims for invasion of privacy, violation of the right of publicity, defamation, and copyright infringement or for any fees for use of such record media.

If a library patron does not wish themselves or their child to be photographed, the patron must notify Nesmith Library staff to that effect. No names will be used in conjunction with photos/video without express written consent.

Photography and Recordings in the Library

We seek to respect all requests to remove social media posts featuring photos on Nesmith library channels but cannot enforce any limitations on the public. Nesmith Library is a public building and as such cannot control non-staff or patrons taking photos or videos in public locations on premises.
