We will sing along with the original cast, all of your favorite songs from the show. And answer trivia questions about Hamilton the man, the show and his time in history.

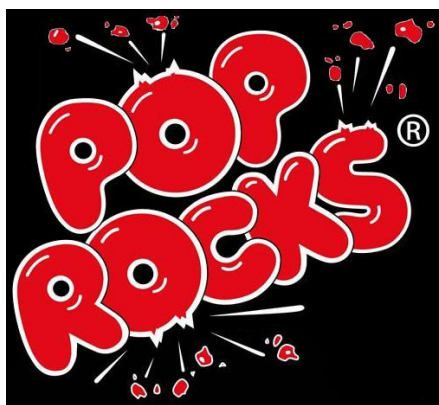

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## Pop Rocks Rock! And Rock Bracelets

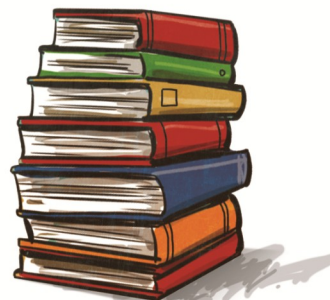
